Instructions for Celtic Whole Cloth Quilt

This pattern is designed to stitch out at 100" square with 1" margins all around. If you have 21" of throat sewing space you can stitch this pattern. If you want to reduce the size of this quilt you would need to put all patterns onto the CAD screen and reduce them all at the same time in order for it to work. Use the top/bottom border pattern to guide your size. Example: if you wanted an 80" square quilt, reduce all patterns until the top/bottom pattern is 80".




Sewing order for whole cloth

- 1. Stich top border
- 2. Turn quilt
- 3. Stitch the two side borders, carefully lining up connecting lines.
- 4. Turn quilt
- 5. Stitch bottom border, carefully lining up connecting lines at both ends.
- 6. Put a mark 51" from left edge and 14 inches dow. Place your tree part 1 pattern so that the tip is at that mark. See diagram 1.



- 7. Roll quilt, line up pattern 2 carefully lining up connecting lines.
- 8. Stitch tree part 2
- 9. Repeat step 7 for tree parts 2-6

Pattern Names

- 10. Roll back to the top of quilt
- 11. Stich first repeat of cross hatching pass trimming out the border and tree parts, roll quilt
- 12. Repeat step 11 for the other 5 passes of the cross hatching
