Crosshatch Measurements

If you need Kim to draw a crosshatch pattern for you, and you need the grid to be a specific size, Kim is going to need to know which style of measurement you are using.

Example:

If you want a crosshatch grid to be a 1" grid, do you want it to measure one inch along the side of one square (Style A), or do you want it to measure one inch diagonally (Style B). It makes a big difference.

If you reference this cross hatch measurement style in your design request, it will speed things up, as Kim won't have to ask for that information when your design request arrives at the top of the list.
