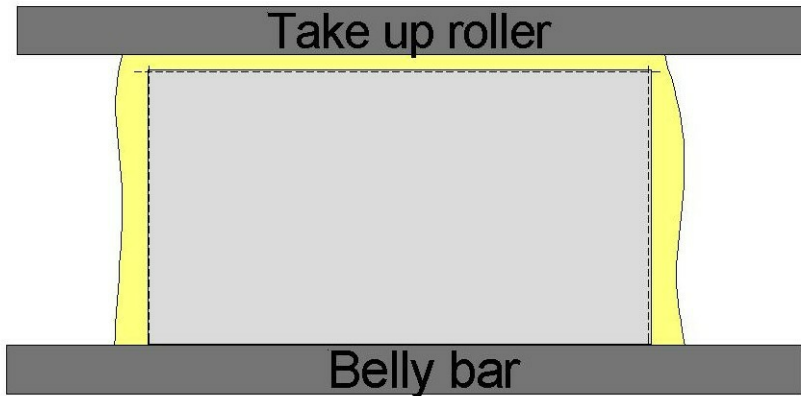
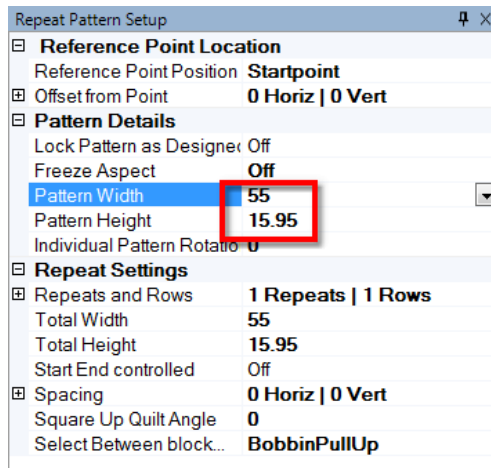


Instructions for using Christmas Stocking patterns on a Statler Stitcher

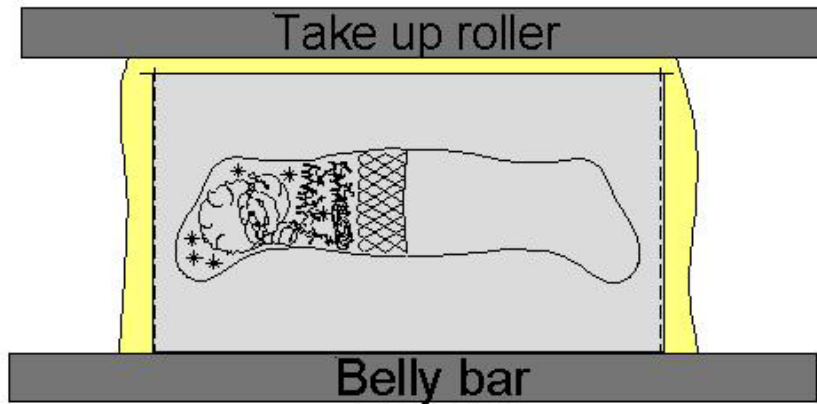
Load backing, batting and stocking fabric on the machine. The backing fabric will be covered with the lining so you can just use muslin.



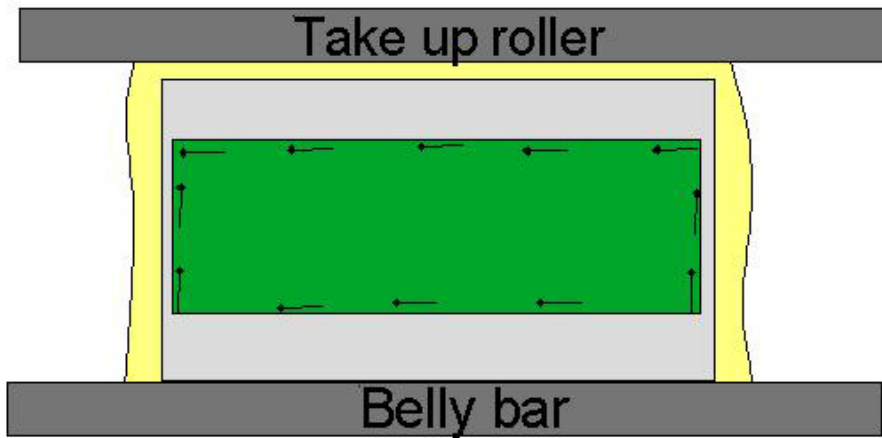
As designed, the stocking is about 44 inches wide, I like using the 60 inch wide taffeta or satin decorator fabrics so I enlarge the stocking to 55 inches wide. Make sure that you have freeze aspect on when you adjust the width.



Once the design is quilted the machine will pause.

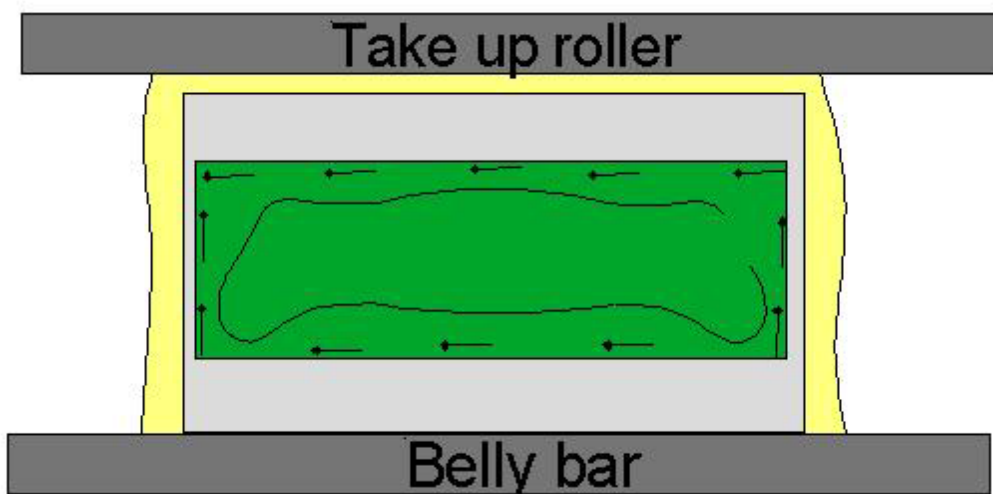


Now you need to clip the bobbin threads and slide the lining fabric under the hopping foot and make sure it covers the quilted stocking.

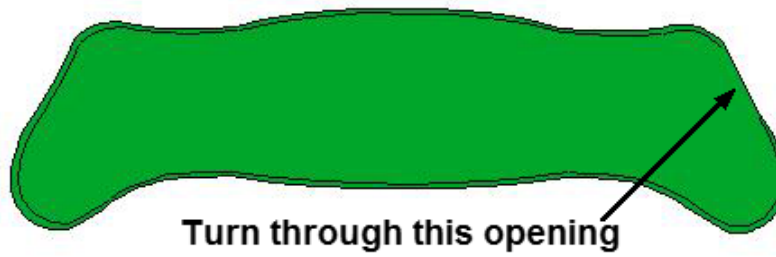


Since the statler is paused, I just use pins to hold the fabric down. Click continue to continue quilting.

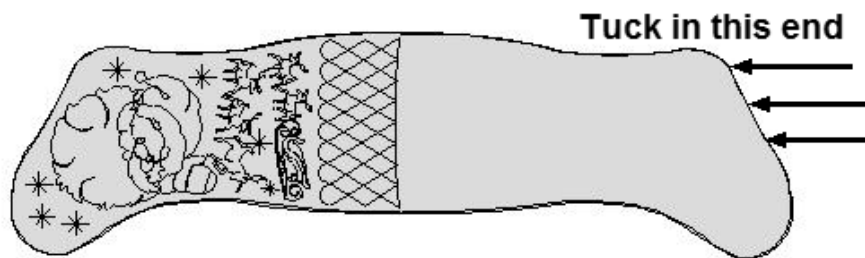
Now the quilting will stitch a line that is inside the last sewing lines by about 1/4".



Cut out around the stocking.



There is an opening at the bottom of the unquilted side.
Turn the stocking right side out through this opening.
Now we have a quilted front end and an unquilted back end.



Tuck the unquilted back end into the front end. Add a hanger and you are ready to go.
