
Club Notes: Baron



The Amethyst Baron contains 82 patterns, including 17 panos.












The Beaded Curtain Collection




The above is a screen shot from the Statler Stitcher Creative Studio software showing how to take advantage of the concatenating feature to use all the individual patterns in the Beaded Curtain Collection. These are very versatile, as you can also use them for borders and in point-to-point applications.


Back when we created all the concatenating ribbon patterns, we checked with the creators of the CompuQuilter and the IntelliQuilter systems to make sure they could use concatenating patterns. We were assured that these systems can handle this function, so if you don't own a Statler please check with your company's software support for assistance with this feature. Statler owners should be sure to download the training manual from the Gammill web site. The exercises include concatenating pattern use.





There are a few other Christmas Stocking patterns included in the Amethyst Baron. **Stocking 5 with cuff** has a blank cuff. You can use this blank cuff to personalize a stocking with a name. Statler users can use the text tool. In order to add in a name, you'll need to add the name to the blank area of the cuff, change the sewing order so that the name stitches first, then the primary stocking, and then the outline for the stocking lining. (For the CQ and IQ users, you'll need to contact your company for assistance with this feature.)

















Raw Edge Appliqué



Stitch out a grid and use these patterns to create a whole cloth quilt. Or, quilt your quilt, and add the shapes stitched out over contrasting fabric to add another dimension. This is a fast way to make a shape & color recognition quilt for a toddler. Just trim away the excess fabric (carefully).
