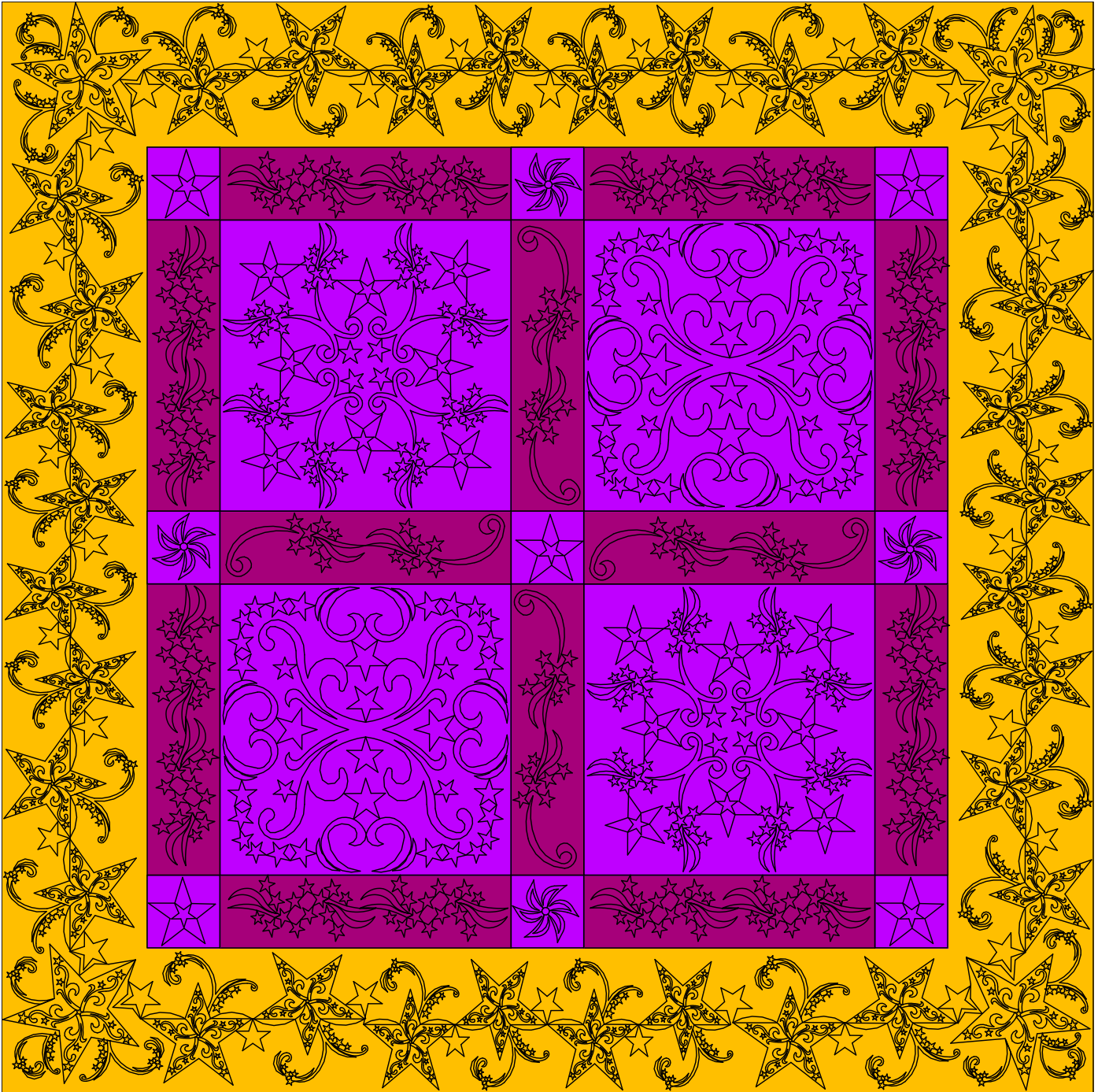


Set this up by using the new holly border corner and holly border pattern, the holly wreath pattern, with crosshatching in the background.

Try matching your crosshatch thread to the background and use a contrasting thread for the wreath and the holly borders.

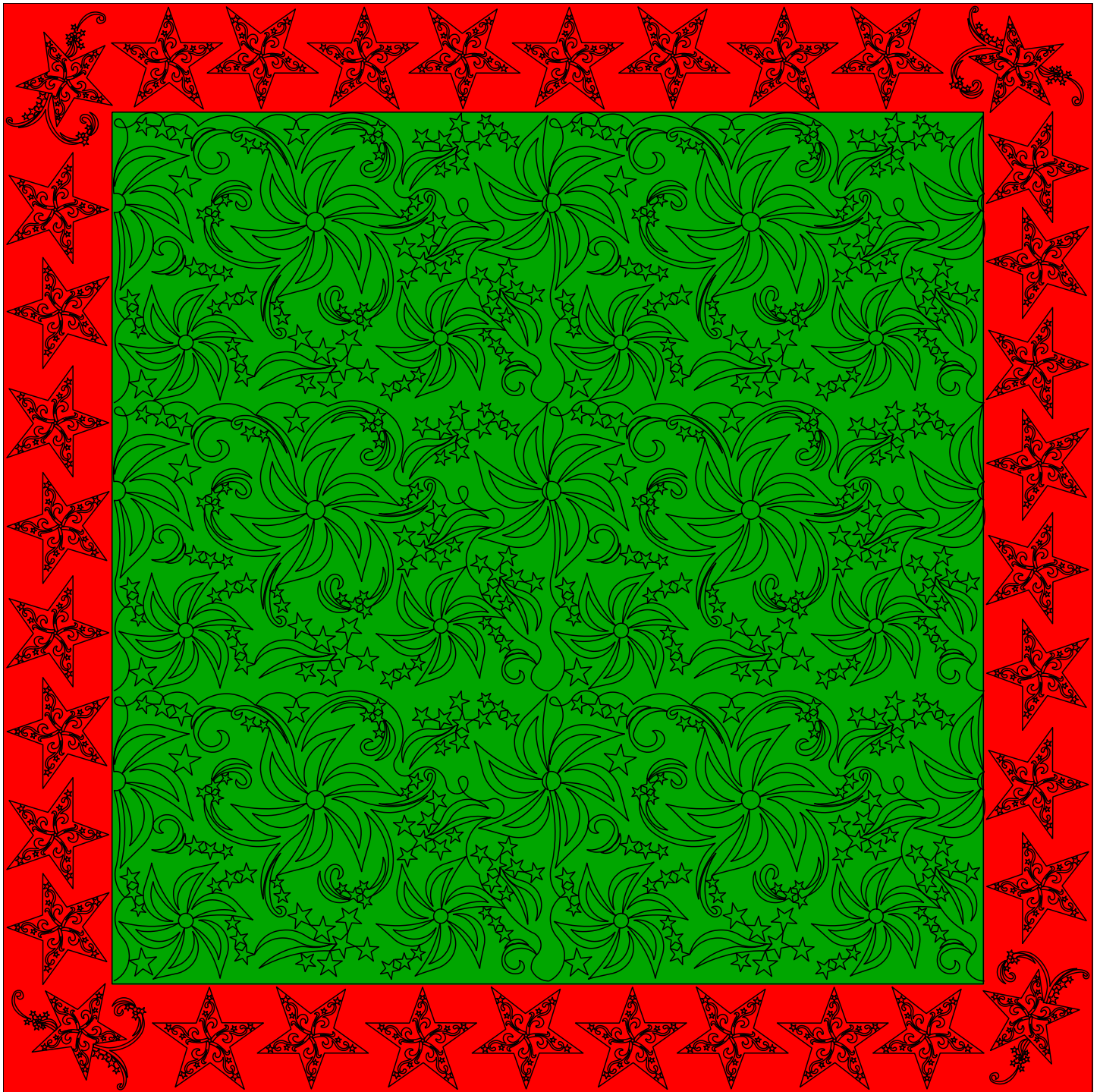


This sample uses the new holly pano squared in a border-to-border application and the new border and border corner patterns to frame it.



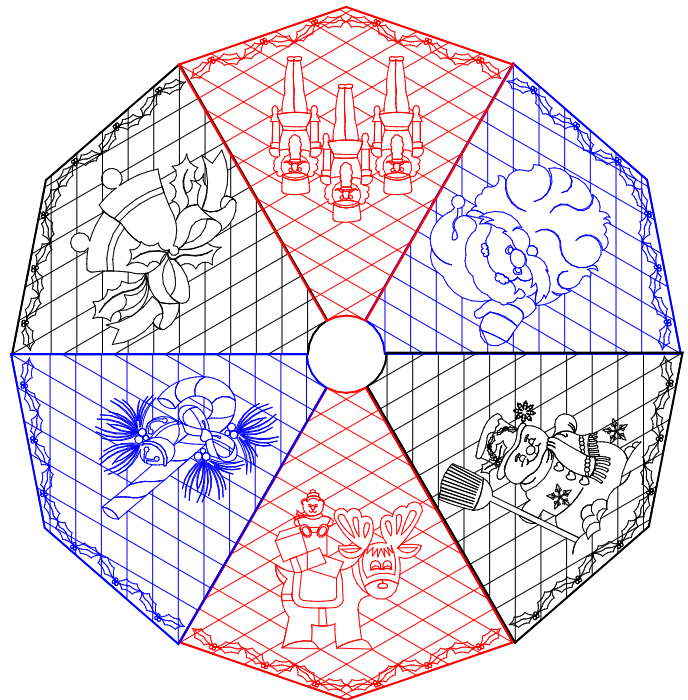
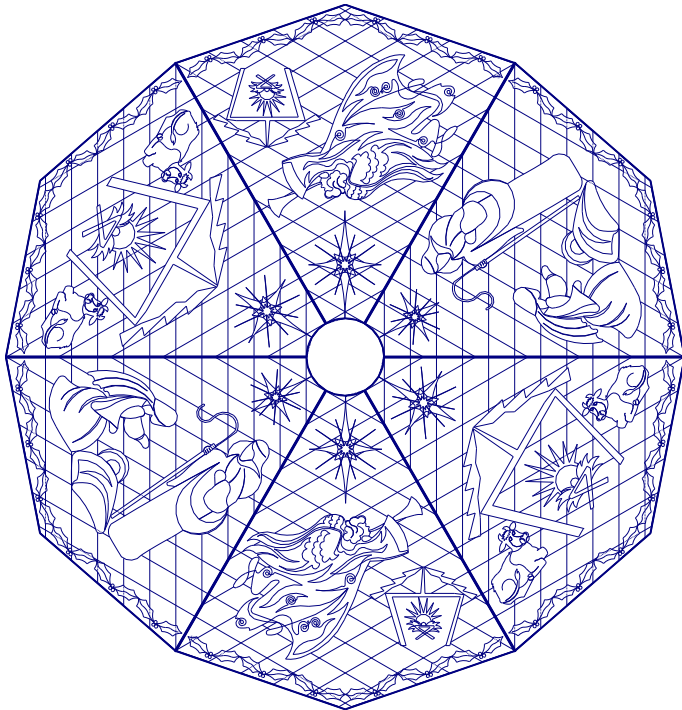
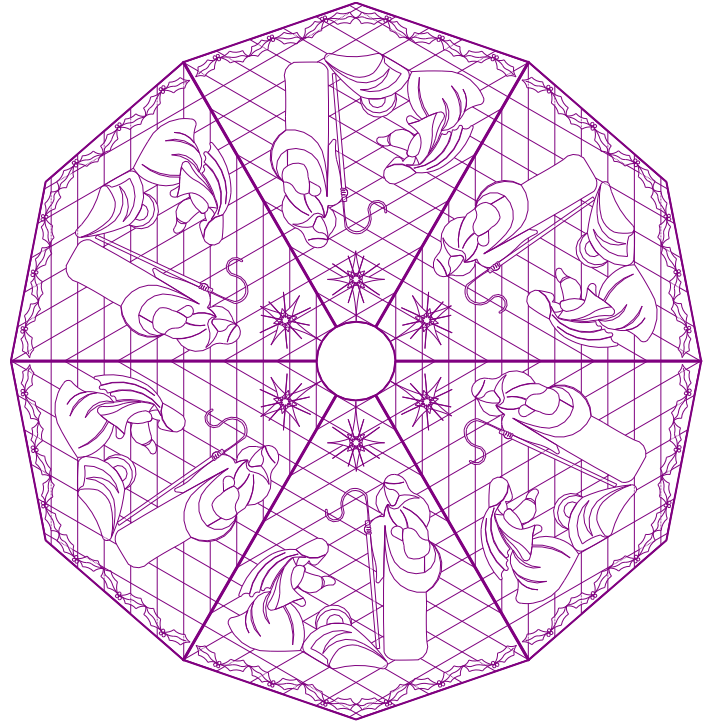
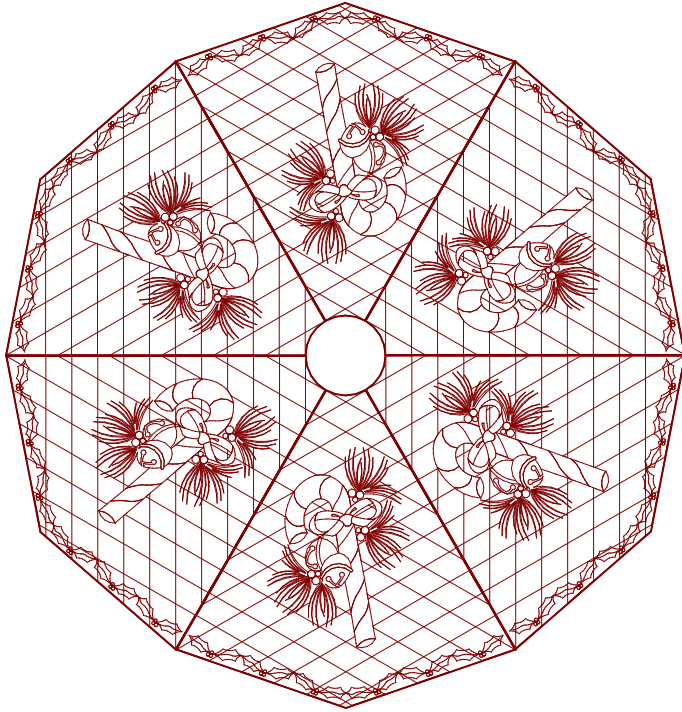
