I believe this pattern is truly inspired!! It's clean and simple at first glance. It has good stitching coverage. The pattern itself is highlighted above. Look how the rows create another leaf! I've already stitched this pano out on a customer's quilt. I used a King Tut variegated thread, and just couldn't get over how great it looked on the quilt! You can't tell where one row ends and the next begins, which is very unusual for a non-interlocking pattern. You guys are going to be looking through your quilts for a quilt you can use this one on!

The Athos patterns are a blend.

For those large blocks which need a more intense quilting application, there are several options. Also, for those small cornerstone blocks, or simply blocks of eight or six inch dimensions, there are any number of pattern in this collection which will stitch out quickly but with a flourish!
