Club Diamond E2E Only Pattern Club

Lite Version Characteristics:

- Patterns are in the 10" height range.
- Have less detail/density.
- Have minimal backstitching.
- Stitch quickly.

Regular Version Characteristics:

- Patterns range in height from 8" to 20"
- Have more detail and more density.
- May have backstitching.
- Take longer to stitch.

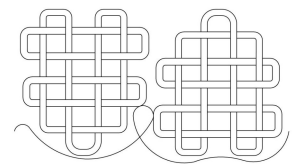
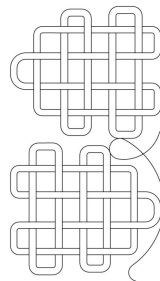
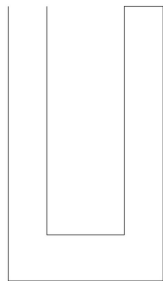
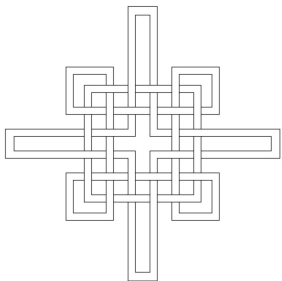
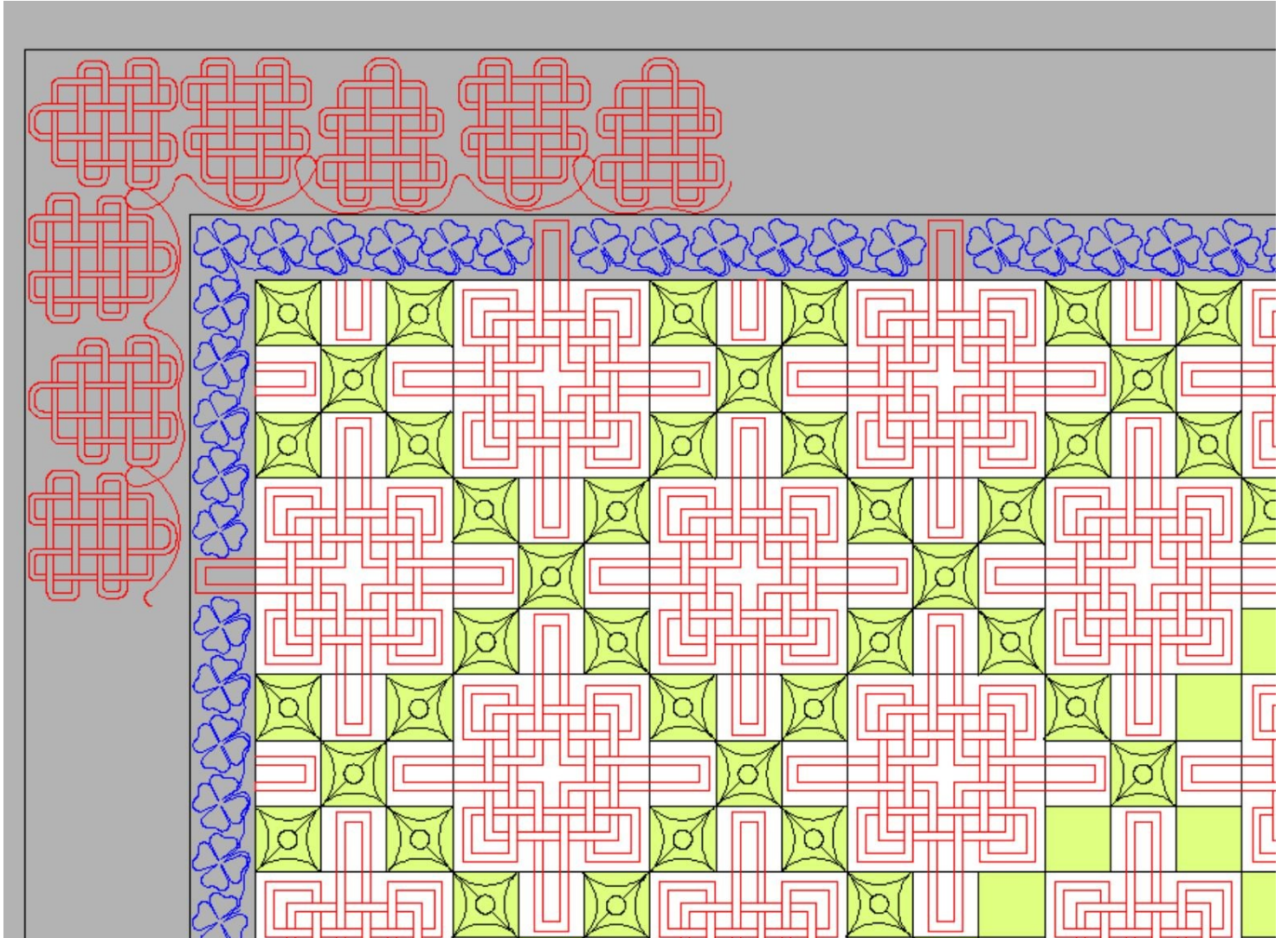

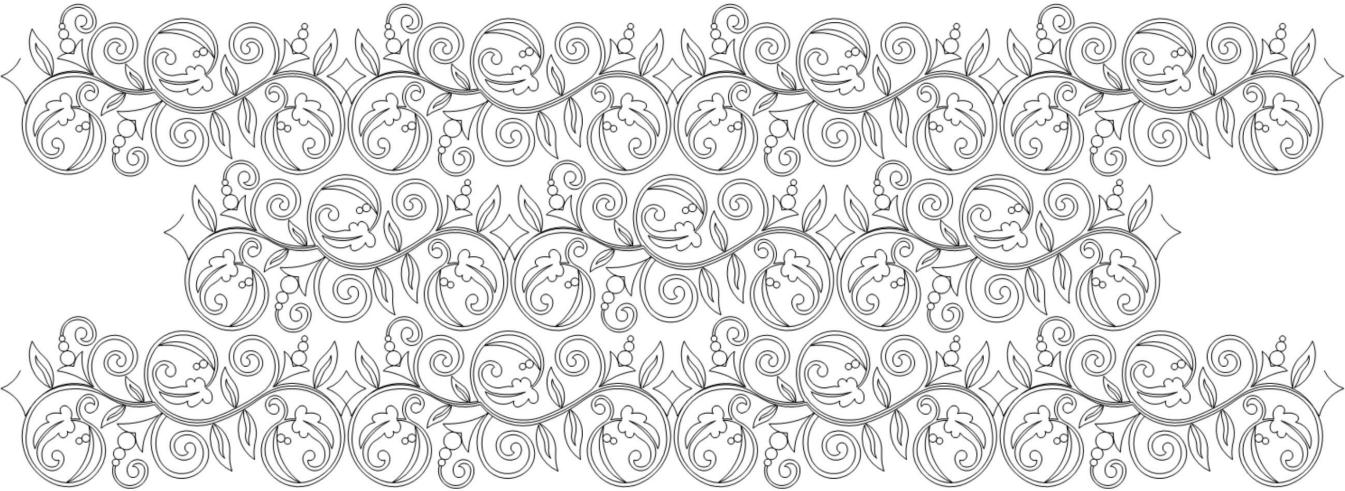
Sew Kind of Wonderful Posh Sunflower Patterns

Felt Food — Italian



Stitch these out and make a playset of felt food for your favorite toddler. Makes a great car toy.

The Name Panos...sigh!

—I do my level best to talk my quilting customers OUT of stitching name panos on their quilts. Why? Because I think they almost always detract from the quilt itself AND you can't read the names from the back-side of the quilt. My personal quilting philosophy is to "do no harm" which means not quilting elaborate designs on a quilt just because I have a computer guided longarm which allows me to do so. Just because you CAN does not mean you SHOULD.

—Regardless, name panos are popular, especially around Christmas and Graduation seasons. Consequently, this archive contains more name panos than I would like. Most of them you will never have a use for, so just cull them out and forget about them. That's what I do...they don't make it onto my Statlers. If you need one, you can always ask me to send it to you again.

—Almost every single name pano started out life as a "normal" pattern, to which we were requested to add a name. The original "normal" pattern is probably NOT included in the current archive, as it was created at some time in the past. That's one reason why CJC members get a 20% discount on all online pattern purchases.

—From time to time we poll our Crown Jewels Club members and ask them if they'd like us to delete all those name panos from the archive. As Crown Jewels Club members, you pay the \$50.00 monthly fee and get EVERYTHING Kim draws...including the name panos, and apparently, you want them all. Very few people (much to my surprise) voted to have them culled out prior to release.

Statler Owners Upgrading to Creative Studio 7.3 and 7.5 (please read)

Plan your software upgrade! If you have quilts to run and cannot afford any downtime, wait until your quilt load eases up before uploading.

Some people have had better luck downloading the software to a usb stick and upgrading their Statler and their Stand Alone Mode computers from the usb stick, rather than opening the Creative Studio software and then letting it upgrade from that point.

















Statler Owners: If you're using CS 7.5.4 are your encrypted patterns suddenly have a dark gold background (instead of light yellow), LOG OUT of your Creative Studio Cloud Database. Reboot your Creative Studio software and then log back into your CS Cloud Database. Your patterns should then be light yellow (which means that they will stitch). If you still have problems, sync your patterns to your Gammill Pattern Cloud Account.

If you upgrade to Statler's Ascend, Gammill will make all of your patterns (in your Gammill Pattern Cloud Account) work with your new system, but you will need to contact SDQS with your new Statler Gold Key number.

Ravioli Noodles

 Start with 2 layers of felt (pasta colored). At pause for thread change just continue. Trim. After done cut apart using pinking shears or rotary blade to create the little pillows of pasta.

Spaghetti/Fettuccine Noodles

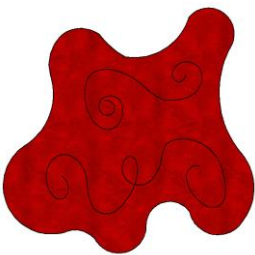
 Start with 2 layers of felt (pasta colored). At pause for thread change just continue. Trim. You will have to cut apart all the strands to create your noodles.

Lasagna Noodle



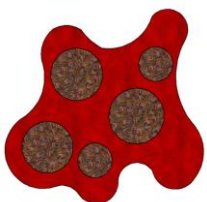
Start with 2 layers of felt (pasta colored). At pause for thread change just continue. Trim. Be sure to make several noodles.

Sauce

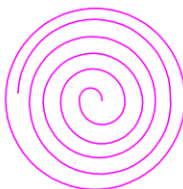


Start with 2 layers of felt (sauce colored). At pause for thread change just continue. Trim. You could make red (marinara), white, orange (cheese), green (pesto) colored sauces.

Red Sauce with Meatballs

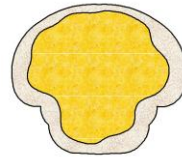


Start with 2 layers of felt (sauce colored). At the first pause you will put on the brown colored felt. Stitch then trim.



Shrimp

Start with 2 layers of felt (shrimp colored). At pause for thread change just continue. Trim.



Garlic Toast

Start with 2 layers of felt (bread colored). At the first pause you will put on the yellow butter colored felt. Stitch then trim.



Mushroom

Start with 2 layers of felt (mushroom colored). At pause for thread change just continue. Trim.



Tomato Slice

Start with 2 layers of felt (tomato skin color). At the first pause you will put on the tomato guts colored felt. Stitch then trim.

Cucumber Slice



Start with 2 layers of felt (cucumber skin color). At the first pause you will put on the cucumber guts colored felt. Stitch then trim. Make sure and make several slices of cucumber.

Onion Slice

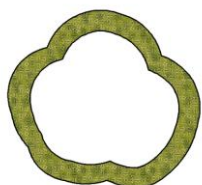
Start with 2 layers of felt (onion color). At pause for thread change just continue. Trim. For a red onion you could quilt with purple thread.

Lettuce Leaf ~



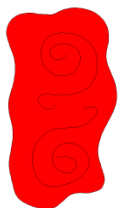
Start with 2 layers of felt (lettuce color)
At pause for thread change just
continue. Trim. Make sure and make
several pieces of lettuce.

Pepper ring ~



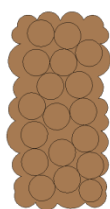
Start with 2 layers of felt (pepper
color). At pause for thread change
just continue. Trim. You will need to
trim out the inside of the ring when
you are done. You can make red,
green, orange, and yellow peppers.

Lasagna Sauce ~



Start with 2 layers of felt (sauce color)
At pause for thread change just continue.
Trim. Make sure and make several pieces of
sauce.

Lasagna Meat ~



Start with 2 layers of felt (meat color)
At pause for thread change just continue.
Trim. Make sure and make several pieces of
meat.

Lasagna Cheese ~



Start with 2 layers of felt (cheese color)
At pause for thread change just continue.
Trim.
