

Christmas Tree Gift Tag Pattern General Instructions

Machine Settings:

- Turn on "Pause at Jump Stitches.
- Run at 16 stitches per inch.

Materials Needed:

- Backing fabric
- Batting
- Fabric for the gift tag front
- Solid fabric for the part of the tag on which you will write the "to and from" information with a pigma pen.
- Pigma Pen
- Ribbon or cord for attaching to package.

General Stitch Map Order:

- Pattern will stitch the outline 3 times. Bring up bobbin thread and hit "quilt"
- Pattern will stitch the circle for the ribbon hole three times. Bring up bobbin thread.
- Place the solid fabric for the "to and from" section. Use your crosshairs to make sure the pattern is completely covered by this fabric. Pin it in place so that it doesn't shift while quilting, and keep the pins out of the stitching path. Hit "Quilt".

If you are just doing one tag, you are done. Cut it out about 1/8th inch from the outer stitching line. Use curved embroidery scissors to cut out the fabric inside the ribbon hole at the top. Add your ribbon.

Single Tag:

- Load your tag backing fabric, just as you would backing for a quilt.
- Layer your choice of batting and then the fabric for the front of the tag, and baste it or pin it so that it doesn't shift while quilting. Use your crosshairs to make sure the stitching will stay inside the basting and/or pins.
- Hit "Quilt"

Fat Quarter Pattern and Width of Fabric Pattern:

These patterns are designed to quilt multiple tags, all with the same fabrics.
