# Queen Block Layout

1. Check the diagram below (or the chart on page 5 of the Quilt Basics Booklet) to confirm that you have made all 18 blocks.
2. Arrange the 18 large diamond blocks on a design wall into a large starburst.
3. Follow the directions on pages 8-12 to create the background blocks.
4. For ease of construction, the quilt top is assembled into six sections, as shown on page 16.
5. Follow the directions on pages 13-16 to create the sections and assemble the quilt top.




# King Block Layout

1. Check the diagram below (or the chart on page 5 of the Quilt Basics Booklet) to confirm that you have made all 18 blocks.
2. Arrange the 18 large diamond blocks on a design wall into a large starburst.
3. Follow the directions on pages 18-21 to create the background blocks.
4. For ease of construction, the quilt top is assembled into six sections, as shown on page 25.
5. Follow the directions on pages 22-25 to create the sections and assemble the quilt top.
